Visit Lucille Ball's hometown of Jamestown, N.Y. where her grandfather took her to watch Vaudeville and where she bought her first bottle of red hair dye, plus explore fun sites in nearby Erie, PA and the surrounding areas.

Eat Like Lucy meal in the unique setting of the Tropicana Room, a reproduction of the "I Love Lucy" Tropicana Nightclub set located in the upper level of the Desilu Studios. After dinner enjoy comedic entertainment by a stand-up comic.

Visit Lucy Desi Museum & Center for Comedy with reproductions of the I Love Lucy sets in the Desilu Studios as well as personal mementos, a film tribute and even Lucy's Car. A showcase filled with vintage memorabilia as well as costumes that were worn on the show and much, much more.

Enjoy a guided driving tour of Jamestown Highlighting Lucy landmarks. You'll see the homes where Lucy was born and grew up, theaters where she performed, places where she attended school, the cemetery where she is buried with her family, and more.

Enjoy a sightseeing dinner cruise on Chautauqua Lake aboard the Summer Wind.

Visit the Robert H. Jackson Center in Jamestown to learn about Supreme Court Justice from 1941 until 1954. Learn about Jackson's role as the architect of the international trial process and then the chief prosecutor of the surviving Nazi leaders at Nuremberg, Germany.

Visit Tom Ridge Environmental Center on Erie's Presque Isle where you will enjoy a video and displays describing the ecosystem of the area, the 75 foot glass tower allows for great views (with elevator and stair access) for great views, and guided driving tour with lighthouses and landmarks.

Enjoy Erie Maritime Museum where exhibits including a short video illustrate the dramatic story of the Battle of Lake Erie and the War of 1812. If in port we will visit the U.S. Brig Niagara, a reconstructed flagship.

Visit the historic Union Station where you'll enjoy an introductory welcome including history of the building and a few ghost stories, buffet dinner in the Concourse of Union Station's ballroom, plus a sample of beer from the on-site brewery.

Enjoy a visit to the Kinzua Gorge, just outside of Mount Jewett, to enjoy great views from the site's glass-bottomed skywalk which extends 600 feet over and 230 above the bottom of the gorge. This gorge was the home to the Kinzua Viaduct, built in 1882 as a railroad bridge to span the 2053-foot wide gorge.

Enjoy a visit to the Zippo Visitors Center in Bradford which is "truly enlightening." This unique museum showcases two American icons, the Zippo lighter and the case knife. Enjoy a variety of historical and quirky displays including a 7x11 American flag comprised of 3,393 red, white and blue lighters. (Note if anyone has a Zippo Lighter that needs to be repaired they can bring it with them as Zippo will accept items for repair and shipment back to the owner.)

We will visit the Barrel House Restaurant at Lantz Corners, PA for a lunch before heading back to Delaware.
