He will also discuss what we can do about the problem.

Ted was trained by the Al Gore "Climate Reality Project" and "Citizens Climate Lobby". He taught weather and climate while a physics professor at West Liberty University in West Virginia.

# **Advocacy Update**

**HB 205-DE EARNS** – carried over from last year. AARP's effort to establish, along with the state treasurer, a retirement plan for employees

(estimated to number 145,000) small employers who don't have the resources to sponsor such a plan. Good News – it's looking food for the Governor to include funding in his proposed 2023 budget. Bad News – the Federal Reconciliation Bill, at this point, includes a Federal Auto – IRA mandate. There's a possibility of getting a vote on our bill during a special legislative session in early November. Stay tuned.

The Credit for Caring Act is currently included in the Federal Reconciliation Bill with a \$2,000 tax credit for caregivers.

We are pushing congress to allow Medicare to negotiate drug prices which would lower drug prices.

We will be advocating in the upcoming session of the state legislature for **Paid Family and Medical Leave and Absentee Voting**. We will be calling on you for assistance to get these bills through the General Assembly at the critical times.
