Berthed at Nauticus, the Battleship *Wisconsin* is one of the largest and last battleships ever built by the U.S. Navy. Battleship *Wisconsin* (BB-64), an Iowa-class battleship, was the second ship of the United States Navy named in honor of the 30th state. Her keel was laid down on January 25, 1941 at the Philadelphia Navy Yard. She was launched on December 7, 1943 sponsored by Mrs. Walter S. Goodland, and commissioned on April 16, 1944, with Captain Earl E. Stone in command.
